Detrixhe and Sheridan Memorial Trophies

Teams are competing this weekend for the James Detrixhe and Billy Sheridan memorial trophies.

Jim Detrixhe, Lehigh '62, was a champion in this tournament for The Hill School and later an eastern title-winner for Lehigh. He gave his life as an Army ranger captain in Vietnam. Billy Sheridan, a collegiate wrestling pioneer,

coached Lehigh from 1912 through 1952, establishing the Engineers as eastern and national powers.

The Detrixhe Trophy goes to the highest scoring team in the undergraduate division. The Sheridan Trophy is presented to a post-graduate division team if its point total is higher than the undergraduate winner's score.
