John Vaow, of Milton Hershey, scored a victory in the tourney's final bout Saturday to give his team the points it needed to tie Hill School for top honors in the 28th annual Lehigh Prep School Wrestling Tournament at Grace Hall.

Milton Hershey and Hill each accumulated 92 points to top third-place Bryn Athyn which trailed with 62.

Bob Fehrs, 123-pound champion from Milton Hershey, was voted Most Outstanding Wrestler of the tourney. He decisioned Dickie Musick of Norfolk in the title round, 7-2. Last year he won at 115.

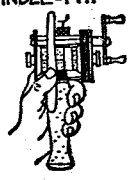

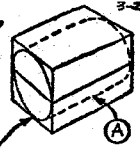
