# Chattanooga Matmen Annex Prep Crown

Ten years of frustration ended for the Baylor School of Chattanooga, Tenn., Saturday night as the Rebel wrestlers won the 35th annual National Independent College Preparatory Schools and Academies wrestling tournament.

The Tennessee school had just one champion, Al Wilson at 133 pounds, but scored heavily in the consolations as well as a taking two seconds, to outdistance runnerup Hill School, 59-47.

Bob Baretta of Penn Charter was the only one of four defending champions to retain his crown as he edged Howard Benedict of Suffield Academy, 1-1, 1-0 in overtime at 178 pounds.

Baylor's Randy Weinberg was the only other defending champion to reach the finals and he dropped a 3-3, 0-0 referee's decision to John Osborn of Haverford.

Walt Sexton of New York Military Academy was a runaway winner for the most valuable wrestler award. The well-built 188-pounder flattened every opponent he faced and allowed just one point in the tournament, an escape by Tom Carter of Lawrenceville. Sexton erased that quickly with a fall in 1:10.

Placing behind Baylor, which failed to win in nine previous attempts, and Hill in team points were Milton Hershey, 43; McCallie, 41; St. Benedict's, 38, and Lawrenceville, 25.

# Hill School Cops Prep Meet Title

Hill School had more than double the number of points its nearest rival had to breeze to the team championship in the 36th annual National Prep School wrestling tournament at Lehigh's Grace Hall Saturday night.

The Pottstown preparatory grapplers amassed 111 points to easily outdistance runner-up McCallie School of Chattanooga, Tenn. which finished with 49 points. Two Pennsylvania schools tied for third, Mercersburg and Milton Hershey, each with 42 points.

Hill's Doug Schutte, a Pennsylvania native now residing in Kansas, a defending champion, captured most valuable wrestler honors en route to the 115-pound crown.

Joining Schutte in the winner's circle for Hill were Greg Penny (122), George Baker (129), Tom Moore (141), Boris Holmes (148) and Steve Bissell (188).

Falls were registered in the finals by Bill Sutherland (158) of Mercersburg, Mike Sokolowski (170) of Milton Hershey and Art Garwood (heavyweight) of Haverford.

Other champions were Brian Card (101) of McCallie, Eric Kennedy (108) of University School and Tom Hall of Hawken.

## Milton Hershey Takes Top Spot In Prep School Mat Tourney

Milton Hershey School dethroned Hill School as champions of the Lehigh Prep wrestling tournament Saturday night at Grace Hall, totaling 70½ points to walk off with 1972 honors.

Haverford was second with 58 followed by Western Reserve 48½, Blair 42½, Hill 39½ and St. Benedict's 38½, to round out the top six.

The Haverford squad sent four men into the finals, with a chance to overtake Milton Hershey, but all were defeated. Hershey only had one title-winner, Frank Campbell at 170 pounds.

Bill Leckonby, director of athletics at Lehigh, presented the James B. Detrixhe Memorial Trophy to Milton Hershey. Gerry Leeman, tournament director, presented the Most Outstanding Wrestler award to Jay Martin, 135-pound

champion from Valley Forge Military Academy.

Martin won four one-sided decisions in the two-day tournament, the last a 10-0 rout of defending champion Tom Hall of Hawken.

Mrs. Billy Sheridan, widow of the great coach who established Lehigh as an eastern intercollegiate wrestling leader, presented awards to the individual champions.

Steve Bissell, Hill School 188-pounder, was the only defending titleholder, of four, to retain his crown. He racked up four falls in four bouts.

Two area grapplers at Blair Academy, 148-pounder George Myers of Emmaus and 158-pounder Mark Lieberman of Allentown, scored falls in the title round. Myers flattened Bob Lister of Milton Hershey in 5:35 and Lieberman pinned Phil

Byrnes of Haverford in 3:29.

It was a well-balanced tournament with no school able to place more than two champions. Blair, Hill and St. Benedict's had two apiece while the others were shared among six schools.

## 2 Area Grapplers Win In Prep Meet

George Myers and Mark Lieberman, 148 and 158-pounders from Emmaus and Allentown, both representing Blair Academy, were among first-day survivors yesterday in the 37th annual Prep School Wrestling Tournament at Lehigh University.

Both were scheduled to move into semi-final competition at noon today. Consolation bouts will follow and championship pair-ups are slated for 7 p.m. on the Grace Hall mats.

WLVT-TV, Channel 39 of the Lehigh Valley, will tape the finals for showing tomorrow at 4 p.m.

Lieberman, whose older brother Mike was a freshman standout on this season's Lehigh team, racked up two falls in two appearances. Myers went to the mat three times, scoring a fall and two decisions.

Defending champions Tom Hall (135) of Hawken and Steve Bissell (188) of Hill advanced to the semis. Two other title-holders are missing. Erie Kennedy (108) of Univ. School wasn't among the entries. George Baker of Hill was beaten in the opening round by Jim Slabonik of Milton Hershey, 18-14.

Haverford was the leader through the quarterfinals with 18 points but four others in a tightly-bunched field were pushing hard for the top spot. Western Reserve, Blair and Milton Hershey had 17½ apiece and Hill, the defending champ, had 15½.

No less than 24 schools are represented in the semifinals, led by Western Reserve with six men, Milton Hershey with five, Haverford with four and Germantown Academy with four.
